Maintenance Operator Position

Coolin Sewer District is currently accepting applications for a full-time Maintenance Operator to assist in operating and maintaining their wastewater system (collection, treatment and land application).

Applicants must have the following minimum license classifications for the State of Idaho or be able to obtain them within 90 days of job offer. "Operator in Training" licenses will be considered. Training licensing & fees reimbursed by the District. Applicants must provide documentation so that licenses can be obtained.

- Wastewater Collection Operator – Class 1
- Wastewater Treatment Operator – Class 1
- Wastewater Treatment Operator – Land Application

A partial list of responsibilities follows:

Operate the District's wastewater system in accordance with Idaho Law, including but not limited to:

- Operate and maintain sewer lift stations
- Conduct all sampling and reporting required for wastewater system
- Operate and maintain treatment and storage lagoons
- Apply treated wastewater at the District's land application site in accordance with the District's reuse permit
- Maintain all documentation related to operations and maintenance of the District's facilities
- Attend regular monthly Board meetings and special meetings if required
- Prepare and provide maintenance reports for the Board of Directors at regular meetings
- Perform sewer locates as requested
- Coordinate new sewer connections
- Maintain District buildings, vehicles, and grounds
- Work with office personnel to manage the business of the District
- Document, organize and submit reports using modern technology
- Coordinate new construction and capital projects
- Communicate with District patrons, personnel and Directors as required
- Participation in an on-call rotation
- Other duties as required

Requirements:

- A combination of education and experience directly relating to the maintenance and operations of the District is preferred, but will be provided if the candidate meets other criteria
- High School diploma or equivalent GED is required to obtain licenses
- A clear felony background check is required to obtain licenses
- Must have a valid driver's license and live within 30 minutes of the District's maintenance shop
